We welcome you to get involved in our city. We, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, invite you to attend Medina's regular monthly board meeting held on the first Monday of each month at 6:00 PM at the Municipal Building- 201 Hwy 45E North. The meetings are open to the public and everyone is encouraged to attend. We firmly believe that successful community relations require a cooperative effort between citizens and city personnel.

Garbage and Bulk Pickup Information:

Weekly curbside garbage pickup is contracted by the City of Medina through Waste Management. Garbage service begins at the time your water service begins, if applicable. You are billed at a rate of **\$22.00** per month on your monthly JEA bill for garbage service. JEA is contracted by the City of Medina for billing of the garbage service only. Waste Management provides the garbage service and garbage cans. If your residence does not currently have two Waste Management cans, call us at #731-783-3913 to have them delivered. Note that the cans are required to remain at the delivered residence if you move from that location. If your garbage is missed, contact us immediately so that Waste Management can be notified. Current garbage pickup for residents in Richmond and Middle School St subdivisions are picked up on Tuesday, Stonecreek, Blackmon, Westwind, Gilbert Lane, Caleb and Joshua streets, Cambridge is picked up on Wednesday, and historic part of Medina on east side of Hwy 45E is on Thursday. Garbage is required to be curbside by 7 AM.

The City of Medina will provide Curbside Bulk Waste Pickup for city residents starting **July 3, 2025**. The City of Medina is assuming the cost for the service for the first year and will re-evaluate thereafter.

Please view the Bulk Pick-Up guidelines below:

- Bulk Pickup is provided on the **first Thursday of each month**. Bulk waste must be at the curbside by 7 a.m. the day of collection. **Items may be placed curbside no earlier than two days prior to pickup date and no later than 7 a.m. the day of collection or homeowners will be subject to violation notifications.** Contractor has a written route of service for pickup per month. Once your route has been covered on the specific date, they will not come back to re-service your area.
- Bulk Pickup is limited to one pile per pick-up date. *Piles should be no larger than 8'x'5'x5' which is approximately the size of the bed of a pickup truck.*
- Bulk items must be placed in front of the residence separate from standard household waste collection receptacles and away from any obstructions including mailboxes, fire hydrants, utility poles, trees, etc.
- Items should NOT be placed in the gutter or over any type of stormwater inlet.
- Do not place items under power lines or on the street.
- Make sure vehicles are not blocking access to bulk waste items.
- Limbs or cuttings should be no longer than *8 feet or more than 12 inches in diameter*, and neatly stacked piles.
- **The City of Medina will not collect waste generated from a contracted service.** Contractor-related tree cutting/construction debris shall be removed and disposed of by the contractor, privately.
- **Demolition or moving clean-out debris will not be picked up.**

- **Hazardous Material will not be picked up.** (Ex: paint, solvents, cleaners, motor oil, tires, televisions, batteries, block material, concrete, dirt or shingles, etc.)
- **Brush and Debris from a lot clearing will not be picked up.**
- Any items left in the City's right of way will be collected as bulk waste (including, for example, furniture, basketball goals, soccer nets, etc.) **The City is not responsible for the accidental removal of items nor or for associated replacement costs.**

Inclement Weather:

When the City of Medina experiences inclement weather, bulk waste collections may be delayed. As soon as the weather permits, the Bulk Waste Pickup Contractor will pick up the missed bulk waste and resume the regular schedule.

City Sticker Requirement:

As a new resident in the City of Medina, you are required to register your vehicles in Gibson County within 10 days of new residency. At time of registration or renewal, you will also pay an annual additional \$15 city sticker fee for each vehicle payable to Gibson County Clerk.

Leash Law Ordinance:

City Ordinance #80-1 provides that it shall be unlawful for any person owning and /or keeping any dog, to willfully permit the dog to run at large upon any public property of the city or run at large or go upon the premises owned or in possession of or under the control of any other person in the city.

Prohibition of Vehicular Parking on City Streets:

City Ordinance #10-02 determines that the public streets in the residential area of Medina are not wide enough to safely accommodate normal traffic flows when motor vehicles are parked on them. No person shall park any motor vehicle on the municipal streets in the residentially-zoned areas of City of Medina with the exception of loading or unloading activities associated with moving or delivering household items provided that such parking does not exceed twenty-four (24) hours.
